

HOOK

Main Focus

This topic will focus upon:

- **English** where the children will explore their rich read before going on to write a persuasive information leaflet on Cornwall.
- **Science** where the children will investigate rocks and soils.
- Geography where the children will compare Totton to Mousehole (a Cornish town).
- Art where the children will look at the work of J.M.W. Turner before creating their own Cornish seascape.
- **Computing** where the children will learn how to use Google Docs.

These are not linked to the topic:

- **PSHE** where the children will learn the importance of respectful behaviours.
- **RE** where the children will explore the concept of 'angels'.

Learning **Experiences**

To complete the Space Race, they will need to read three times a week and record it in their reading diary.


For times tables, they will need to play at least five games a week on TTRS.


Christmas Unit
