Main Focus

This topic will focus upon:

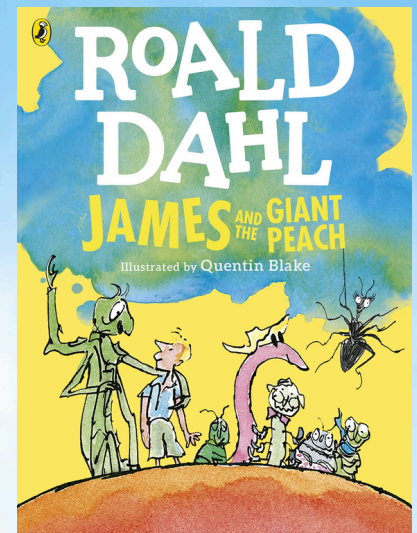

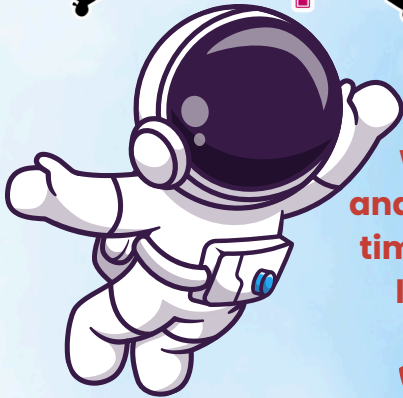


Learning Experiences

- **RE:** working in groups, taking a stand.

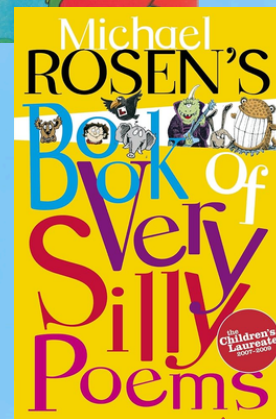
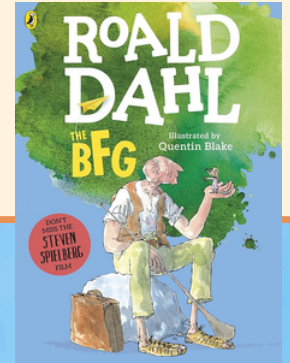
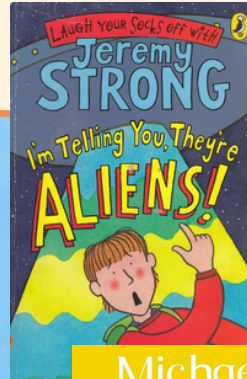


HOME LEARNING
