

Main Focus

The topic will focus upon:

- English where the children will write persuasive letters selling their unique castles, write a story opening and write a diary entry as a ghost in a ghost
- Geography where the children will use atlases to discover locations around the world with differing climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts.
- Science where the children will investigate the movement of light.
- Art where the children will learn about famous architects and castles around the world.
- PSHE where the children will learn about keeping safe online and the dangers of harmful substances.
- RSE where the children will learn about changes in their body as they get older.
- Computing where the children design their own castle using a Computer Aided Design (CAD) software.

Learning Experiences

- Hook: workshop delivered by Simon Chadwick.
 Sketching a fantasy castle, critiquing estate agent sales pitches.
- Art: create junk model castles linked to Gaudi.
- **PSHE:** experiencing a 'Money Management' workshop linked to keeping money safe.
- Geography: using atlas skills, comparing climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts.
- English: writing a persuasive castle sales pitch.
- **English:** writing a gothic 'haunted castle' story opening to create a cliff hanger.

- Science: teamwork, investigations, creating periscopes.
- Computing: learning how to use CAD (Computer Aided Design) software to design a 3D model of a castle.
- **RE:** learning about managing transitions with Southampton City Mission.




Your child will be focusing upon learning these compulsory words this half term. Please help them practise at home:
