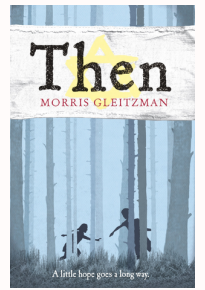

# HOME LEARNING

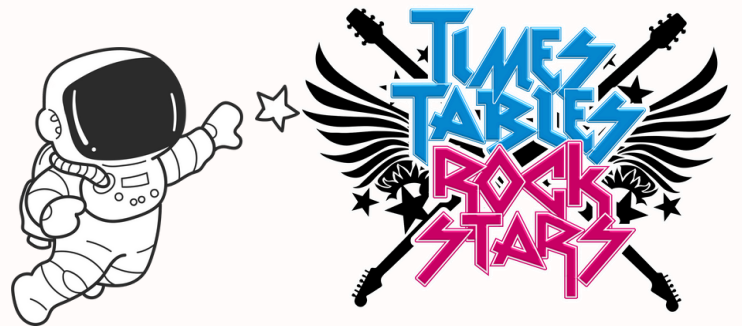


RICH READ

To complete the Space Race, they will need to read three times a week and record it in their reading diary.

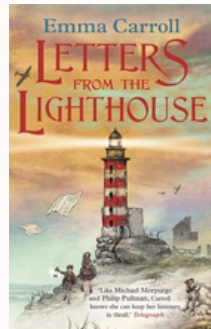


## LEARNING EXPERIENCES
