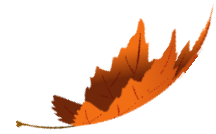

Our Curriculum

It is our goal to provide a curriculum that stretches, challenges and inspires the children. Each half term, the children will be immersed in a topic that surrounds a **'Rich Read'** – a powerful example of children's literature that will provide a stimulus for the children's learning. The topic will stem from a **'hook'**, which will inspire, motivate and excite the children; it will be enriched by trips and visits and will finish with an **'outcome'** – a product of all their learning from that half term.



Highlights of the Year

Year 3

Year 3 have already been visited by the ambulance service and local artist, Simon Chadwick. During the first half of the Autumn Term, they will meet a dog from the 'Pets As Therapy' charity. They will also visit Totton Library. In the second half of the Autumn Term, they will participate in a walk around Totton, which will look at several aspects of the town. They will go on to visit Testwood Lakes in the Spring Term. Finally, they will have the opportunity to visit a Sikh Gurdwara in the Summer Term.

Year 4

As in previous years, the year group plans to run trips to Stubbington Residential Centre the The Southampton Sea City Museum, and to the New Forest; these three trips have previously been very well received. The children will be visited by a theatre company, specialising in Viking Tales, local artist and author Simon Chadwick and Liberty's Owl, Raptor and Reptile Centre. During the year, each class will also get a chance to visit the local swimming pool for swimming lessons.

At the start of each new topic, you will receive a 'Learning Newsletter', which will outline the children's learning journey through the topic. The newsletter, which was sent out last week, will contain the themes of the topic and an overview of the subjects which your child will cover that half term should you wish to explore them more at home.



Reading and Times Tables – the building blocks of learning

Reading

Your child will have daily reading lessons at school. Additionally, your child's teacher and LSA will listen to them read as often as possible. Outside of school, your child will participate in a weekly home learning challenge – The Space Race.

Times Tables

As with reading, your child will have opportunities in school to practise their times tables. As a school, we use the popular times tables platform 'Times Tables Rock Stars'. The interactive game gives our children the opportunity to experience regular, meaningful practice of their times tables and the corresponding division facts. The Year 3 and 4 teachers will set up class competitions to encourage participation. We will also spend time celebrating those children who are putting in effort to improve the accuracy of their times tables.

The National Curriculum requires **all** children to have a secure understanding of all their times tables by the end of Year 4. It is really important that the children use this incredible resource and continue to improve.

Home Learning

In Lower School, your child will have two weekly home learning opportunities linked to reading and times tables. These will start in **Week 4** of this half term. A letter explaining this will be sent out in due course.

Water Bottles

We encourage children to drink water regularly throughout the day as it helps them to concentrate and stay alert. Please send your child to school with a **named** water bottle.



Playtime snacks



Children are allowed to bring in a healthy snack to eat at break time. A number of children with severe nut allergies attend Abbotswood – **we are therefore a nut-free school** and ask that parents do not provide their child with nuts as a snack or for lunch at school.

PE

Your child will have two opportunities each week to enjoy PE. Their year group will have a designated afternoon where they will enjoy Outdoor Sport Activities (O.S.A.). Each class will have an additional session on a separate day where they will do PE with their class. Refer to the table below to see the day of your child's O.S.A. and PE sessions. **Please ensure that your child is wearing their named PE kit in school on their designated PE days. They will be allowed to remain in kit all day.**

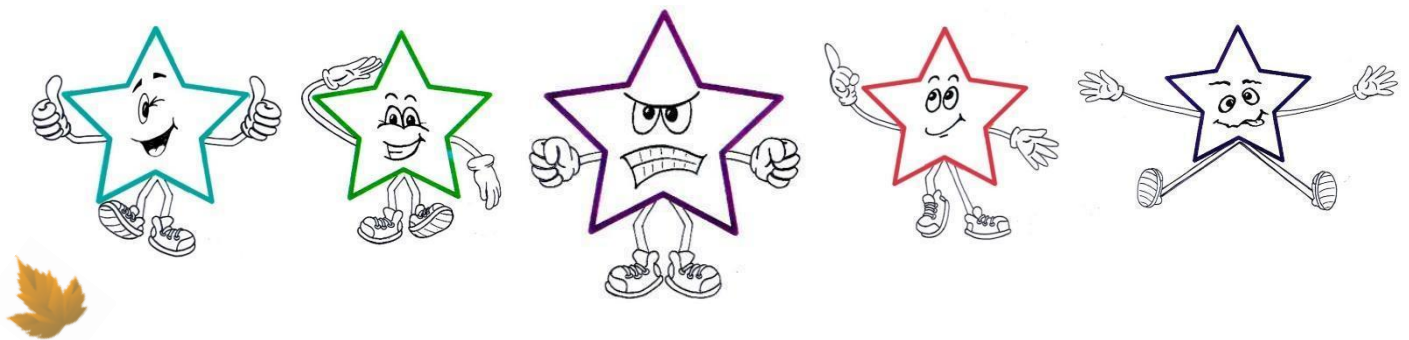
