

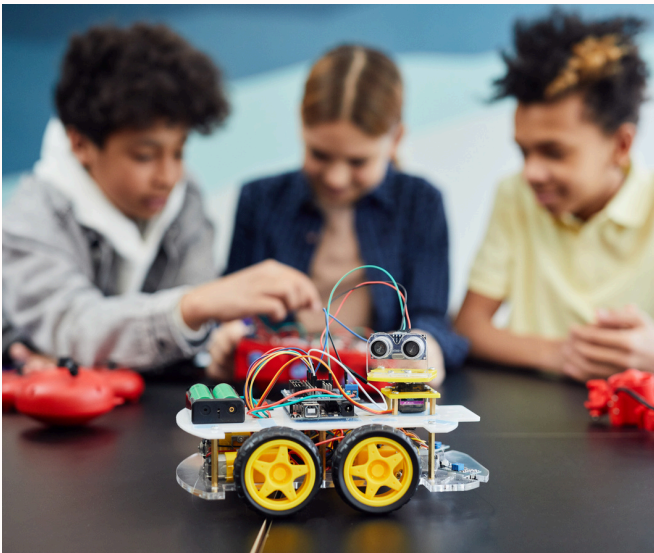
D-DAY LEST WE FORGET

MAIN FOCUS

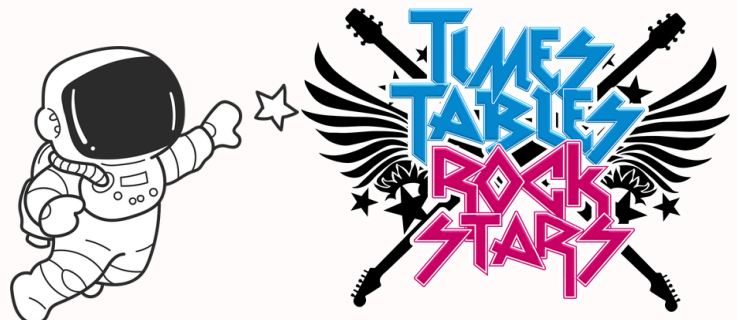
The topic will focus upon:
