Dear Parents/Carers,

Following on from our recent welcome letter, we are writing to give you further details about two key opportunities for your Year 2 child to visit our school if they have been offered a place to start with us in September. The aim of the visits is to allow your child to familiarise themselves with the school and to give them the opportunity to make some new friends, meet their new teacher and visit their new classroom. Running alongside these dates, your child will start to see members of Abbotswood staff in their school assemblies and on their playgrounds.

We would like to invite your child to join us on:

Thursday 25th June

Time: 9.30 -11.00am

Activity: Visiting Abbotswood for part of a morning

Your child will visit Abbotswood for part of the morning where they will meet our Year 3 children and explore the school.

Your child will also:

- Meet some of the existing Year 3 teachers.
- Meet Tommy, our school dog!
- Experience a break time.

Please ensure your child brings a **snack and a water bottle** with them.

Eling and Lydlynch Infant Schools: Drop off at your infant school as usual – your child will be registered and then will be accompanied by staff from their infant school to Abbotswood.

Hazel Wood Infant School: You will need to drop your child off on the Abbotswood front playground at 9.15am where they will be met and registered by staff from their infant school. After their visit, their infant school staff will walk them back to Hazel Wood.

On the afternoon of **Wednesday 1st July**, you will receive a letter informing you and your child of who their Year 3 class teacher will be.

Thursday 2nd July

Time: 9.30 am – 2.15 pm

Activity: Move Up Day

Your child will spend the day with their new teacher and class. Please bring your child to the front gate at 9.30 am. Then, please be ready to pick your child up from the front playground, where you dropped off, at 2.15 pm. Members of staff will be on hand to direct you to your child's class line.
